

What is an Advisory Board?

The Advantage Beauty Institute Advisory Board or "ABIAB" is a team of individuals from various segments of the community—teachers, students, administrators, support staff, business/industry people and other interested community members and stakeholders. The purpose of the ABIAB is to assist the Advantage Beauty Institute in developing and evaluating the results of the school improvement plan and the annual school budget. The ABIAB is composed of "appropriately balanced" number of stakeholders and individuals who are representative of the ethnic, racial and economic makeup of the community served by the Advantage Beauty Institute.

It is the responsibility of the ABIAB to help increase student and the institutions success. In the process of developing the school improvement plan, the ABIAB conducts a biannual assessment that identifies internal and external factors that affect student learning. Then, working with the information revealed by the needs analysis, the ABIAB assists in clarifying the vision for the school and establishing indicators of student success. The ABIAB focuses on the needs of students, including what they need to know (curriculum content) and be able to do (performance application). The plan also should reflect any special interests and needs of the students and community served by the school. Another primary task of the ABIAB is to regularly communicate with other owners, directors, educators, students, and the community stakeholders, about the school improvement plan. Other key responsibilities of the ABIAB include:

- working as a team;
- holding well-publicized, open meetings;
- encouraging innovation;
- involving other members of the school community in the school improvement process
- Gainful employment;
- Trends in the marketplace and shifts in the industry;
- New teaching models;
- Student Instructor relations;

Each school in the State of Florida must have a Advisory Board is comprised of a majority of members who are not employees. "Each advisory council shall be composed of the principal and an appropriately balanced number of teachers, education support employees, students, parents, and other business and community citizens who are representative of the ethnic, racial, and economic community served by the school."
